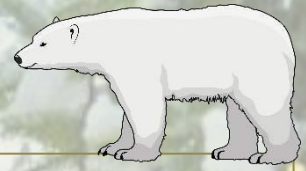

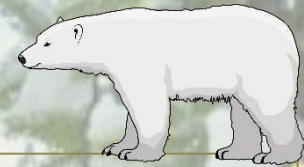

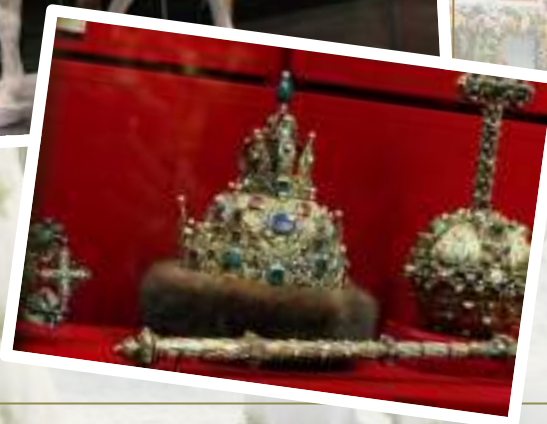


THE KREMLIN ARMOURY

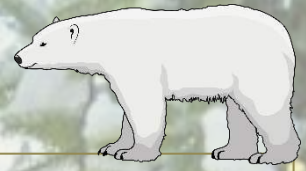
is one of the oldest museums in Moscow. In the halls of the museum you can see grand

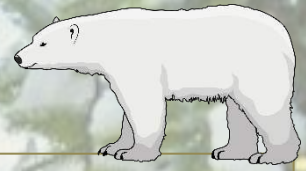


ETERNAL FLAME

You will see the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, which commemorates the soldiers of the Soviet Union who died fighting during World War II. The Eternal Flame that continuously burns in front of it, is like a respect to their sacrifice.



MOSCOW RUSSIA



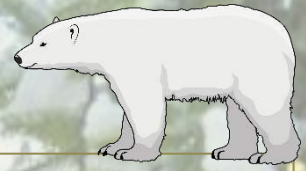
RED SQUARE is the main and the most famous square in Moscow, located in the city center, near the north-eastern wall of the Kremlin. You can see a monument to *Minin and Pozharsky*, and a place where prominent figures of the Soviet State were buried.



LENIN'S MAUSOLEUM is the most emblematic monument of the Soviet era, because inside the embalmed body of *Lenin* is exposed. Lenin's Mausoleum appeared on the Red Square in 1924. Before it, the Alevizov Moat stood in its place, where lions were kept under *Ivan the Terrible's* rule.

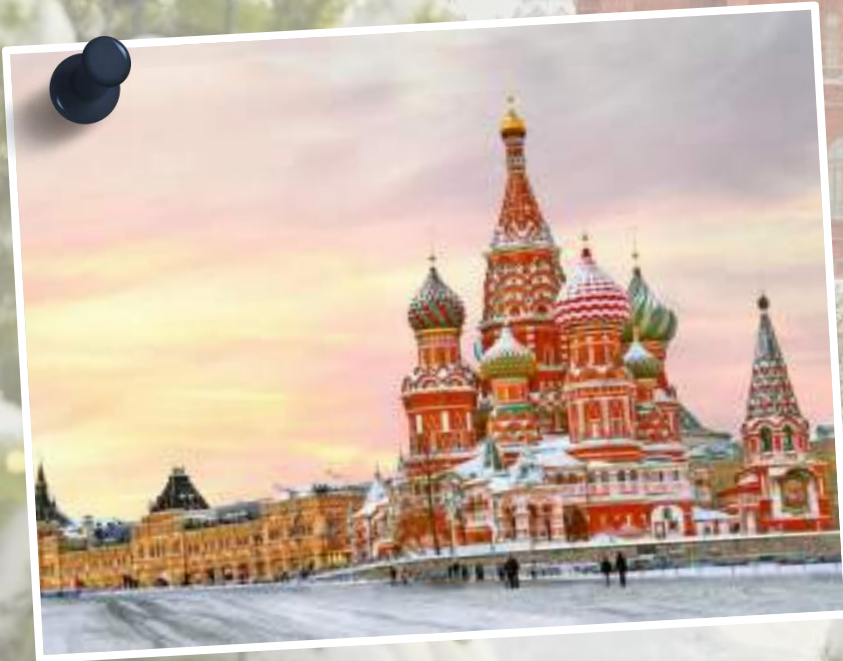

POKROVSKY CATHEDRAL

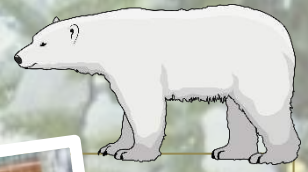
was built from 1555 to 1561 on orders from Ivan the Terrible. It's an Orthodox church in Red Square of Moscow, and is one of the most popular cultural symbols of Russia.



ZARYADYE PARK is a new symbol of the city. Located in the heart of Moscow, a stone's throw away from the Kremlin, it recreates the different landscape of Russia. And there's a unique floating bridge that has become one of the city's main tourist attractions.

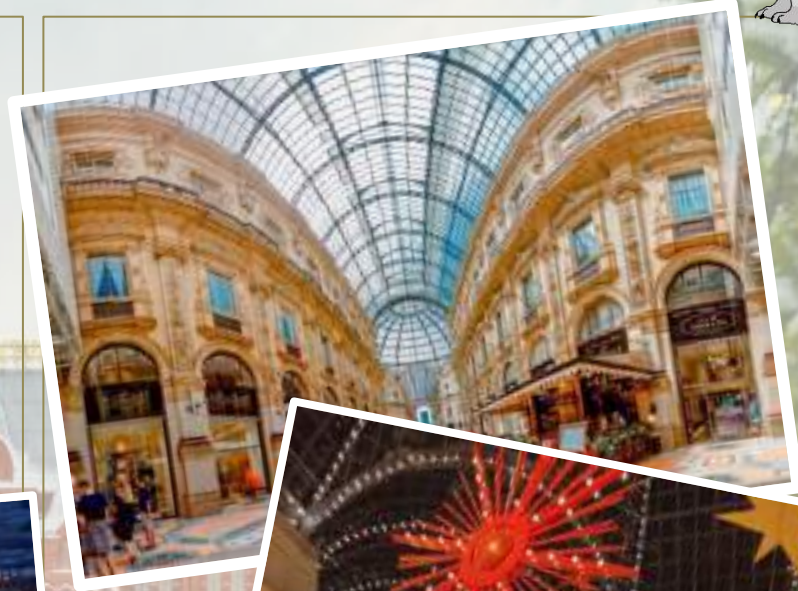

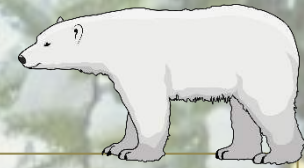


GUM IS THE MOST ICONIC DEPARTMENT STORE

It's a large beautiful store facing Red Square, where high quality Russian and international goods are introduced.

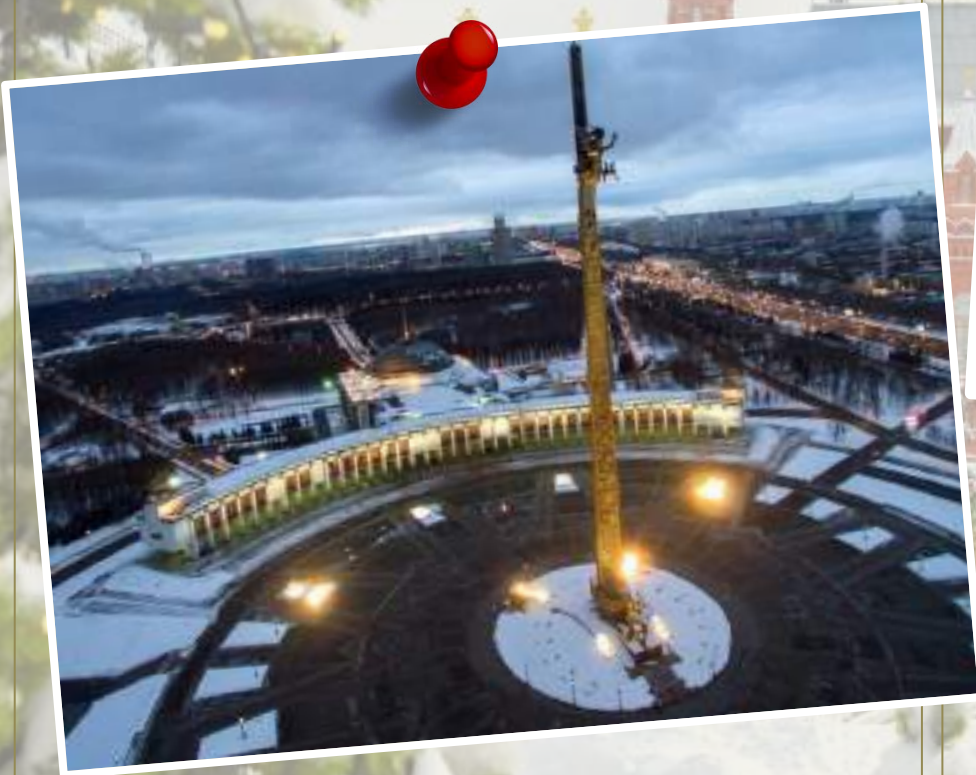

Great Patriotic War of 1941 – 1945.



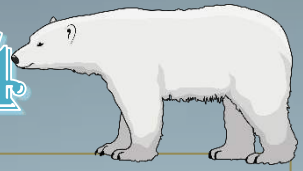

THE HERMITAGE is one of the best and the biggest museums in the world. The museum's collection has about three million artifacts, works of art and monuments of world culture of different times and nations.

CRUISER AURORA is located at the Petrogradskaya embankment, it was considered as one of the symbols of the October Revolution of 1917. The cruiser was officially launched on 11 May 1900 under the personal command of the *Emperor Nicholas II*.
